**EXAMINING BOARD: AQA**

**Minimum Entry Requirements:** Grade 6 in GCSE Spanish

### KEY FEATURES OF THE COURSE:

- Build on knowledge and skills gained at GCSE and deepen understanding of grammar and syntax.
- Enhance written and verbal communication skills, especially expressing considered opinions.
- Facilitate foreign travel and enhance employment prospects.
- Provide an insight into another culture and deepen understanding of world and social issues.
- Study of literary texts including novels and films.
- Study technological, multicultural and social change.
- Independent research project.

### ASSESSMENT

**Listening, Reading and Writing Exam: 50%**

Questions on aspects of Hispanic society, artistic culture, multiculturalism, political life and translation into Spanish.

**Writing Exam: 20%**

Translation into Spanish and questions on film and literary text studied in class.

**Speaking: 30%**

A 21-23 minute discussion on one sub-theme and a presentation and discussion about the student's independent research project.
