

## Pupil Premium 2015/16 Evaluation

Compared to previous years, the Pupil Premium cohort in 2015/16 included more Year 11 students for whom there were additional challenges which impacted on their progress and attendance. The school provided intensive support to maximise progress of disadvantaged students, and although this has not been fully reflected in the GCSE data, students made improved progress throughout Year 11.

Value added calculations for the Pupil Premium cohort as a whole, and by gender shows that there has been an improvement in English from 2014/15, and in particular for Pupil Premium girls.
