

Year 7 Catch-Up Premium Action Plan 2017 - 2018

The evaluation from the 2016-17 catch-up intervention, showed positive outcomes, and therefore the same strategies will be used for 2017-18. The action plan for this academic year will focus on providing extra support for students in both Year 7 and Year 8, based on KS2 data and base-line assessments. The funding will be used for:

- Allocated teaching assistant, with a specialism in mathematics to identified Year 7 and Year 8 mathematics groups.
- 1:1 numeracy intervention programme 'Numicon', to support students who are failing to grasp the basic concepts in mathematics.
- Run additional weekly small group intervention programmes run by a qualified mathematics teacher and additional teaching assistant.
- Group literacy programme, 'Lexia' to run three times a week
- 1:1 literacy intervention programmes, 'Every One Can Read', "Active Literacy Kit' and 'Blue and Green Reading Box' to support students to increase comprehension and reading ages.
- Teaching assistants to listen to students read during Accelerated Reader sessions.

The impact of these interventions will be tracked through progress reports and challenge meetings.
