The Long Eaton School is committed to supporting Fairtrade wherever possible. Fairtrade is about guaranteeing a better deal for producers in the developing world.

The Long Eaton School is eager to ensure that students become global citizens (School Improvement Aim Two) and see Fairtrade as a suitable vehicle to help achieve this. In particular, the school will:

- Ensure learning about Fairtrade happens in a range of lessons and in whole-school activities.
- Support Fairtrade during weekly Eco Club activities
- Encourage use of Fairtrade products wherever possible:
 - Tea, coffee, sugar and biscuits in the staff room and at meetings
 - In cookery activities
 - In the dining hall
- Explore using uniforms made with Fairtrade cotton.
- Ensure Fairtrade products are available wherever possible. For example, at events in the school or community.
- Promote Fairtrade within the school and wider community, particularly during Fairtrade Fortnight.
