Dear Parent/Carer

I am delighted to write to you to confirm details of the Year 11 Prom for 2022. It was with great disappointment that we have had to cancel our last two prom events due to Covid, so we are particularly pleased that we can put the event on this year.

The Prom will take place at Derbyshire County Cricket Club, Derby on Wednesday 29th June from 7pm until 11pm. Further information, including food choices and seating arrangements will be detailed in a future letter.

If you are arranging transport, students should arrive at 6.30pm for a 7.00pm start. The evening will consist of a two course sit down meal, short speeches and a disco and finish at 11.00pm. A soft drinks bar will be available throughout the evening. Following the end of the Prom, it is parent's responsibility to arrange transport home. No student will be allowed to leave on their own.

Tickets will be on sale from Friday 13th April from Student Services and will cost £29.50. Students can pay in full or pay a £10 non-refundable deposit, no later than Friday 27th May to secure a ticket. No deposits will be accepted after this date. All monies should be placed in a sealed envelope, marked with the student's name, tutor group and 'Year 11 Prom'. Cheques should be made payable to "The Long Eaton School". Payment will not be accepted without the attached payment form signed by a parent or carer. The deadline for the balance payment of tickets is Friday 10th June 2022. Alternatively, this can be paid in full via the School Comms App.

Only students from Year 11 on roll at The Long Eaton School may purchase tickets for this event. The ground is providing security and will refuse entrance to any person who is not currently affiliated with the school. Any student who arrives under the influence of alcohol or other substances will be refused admission, and their ticket money will not be refunded. The cricket ground is a non-smoking and non-vaping site. Students will not be allowed to leave the marquee to smoke or vape and need to take this into account when deciding whether or not to purchase a ticket.

As with all special events, we reserve the right to refuse a place to any students whose behaviour in lessons or in social times, respect to staff or students and/or attendance and punctuality, is or becomes an issue prior to the Prom. Should it be deemed necessary to refuse a place to a student who has already purchased a ticket, a full refund will be given. However, consideration may need to be given to the booking of limos and other personal prom related expenses, as the school will not be held responsible for any cost incurred by a student, other than the ticket price, in the event of a place having to be refused.

On the night of the Prom, admission will be by ticket only and any student who arrives without their ticket will be refused admission.

If you would like to purchase a ticket for your child, please complete the reply slip and sign the statement which confirms that you have read and understood the conditions outlined in this letter.

We know that our students this year will show respect to each other, our staff and cricket ground staff at all times and continue to behave in a responsible and civilised manner. However, should it be deemed necessary to do so, a parent may be asked to collect a student before the end of the evening, should any issues arise.

The school has run many successful proms over the years and venues have always been very complimentary about the students – something we are extremely proud of. This promises to be a wonderful evening of celebration to mark the conclusion of the most important phase of your child's education to date. Parents are more than welcome to greet students at the ground, although we ask that in order to make this event go smoothly, parents do not enter the marquee and co-operate with staff on duty and do not step forward when student transports arrive.
