### **Re: School Uniform**

As you will be aware we have a school uniform policy at The Long Eaton School. This ensures that our students look smart and are ready to learn, in addition to the many other benefits that school uniform brings.

It is really important that all students arrive in full school uniform on a daily basis, and I would really appreciate the support from parents in ensuring that this happens.

I have listed the uniform below as a reminder:

- Navy blazer with school logo
- White shirt
- V-neck grey jumper (optional)
- School tie
- Hijab – where students choose to wear the Hijab it should be plain navy or black
- Black, white or grey socks or black tights
- Plain black full length tailored trousers or knee length pleated black skirt
- Black school shoes

### **Items not permitted**

Students are not allowed to wear coloured cardigans or other designer garments instead of their school jumper. Additionally, they are not permitted to wear hoodies or denim jackets, but coats can be worn on the school corridors. Please also ensure that your child does not wear leggings, jeggings or jeans as these are not permitted.


### **Warm weather uniform arrangements**
