**RE: GCSE result day**

I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for GCSE results day this summer.

**Results days**

The date students should come into school to collect their results is **Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> August**. On this day students will be able to collect results from the **Main Hall** from **09:00am until 11.00am**.

Staff will be on hand to support students in making any decisions about their next steps. Students should also bring in a form of photo identification (student ID cards will suffice). Should you be unable to come into school to collect results please contact the Exams Officer on [loe-exams@longeaton.derbyshire.sch.uk](mailto:loe-exams@longeaton.derbyshire.sch.uk) and alternative arrangements can be made.

Certificates will be available for collection from Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2023 from the main school reception.

**TLES 16+ Enrolment**

Enrolment into The Long Eaton School Sixth form will take place at this time. Students who are joining the sixth form will meet with a member of the senior leadership team who will go through their results and complete the enrolment process. If you are yet to apply to the Sixth Form, you can still do so. You can apply in advance of the results day by submitting an application online or apply on results day. Mr Caton will be present on the day to assist with any applications and queries. At this time we will be asking for students to provide us with information about their next intended destination.

**Remarks/appeals**

Should you feel that there are grounds to appeal any of your grades please email the Exams Officer on [loe-exams@longeaton.derbyshire.sch.uk](mailto:loe-exams@longeaton.derbyshire.sch.uk) as soon as possible once you have received your results. This will be considered by a member of the senior leadership team who will be able to respond and advise you of the relevant processes. The deadline for reviews of marking is the 28<sup>th</sup> September.

In some instances we may identify students who are close to a grade boundary and may benefit from having some or all of their exam papers re-marked. In this instance students are required to sign an authorisation form and we will submit this to the exam board at the earliest possible opportunity. Other examination remarks will be looked at on a case by case basis and may incur a charge. Any queries around re-marks should be directed to the above email address.

For more information on next steps once students have received their results, they can also contact the National Exam Results Helpline, run by the **National Careers Service**. They can be called on 0800 100 900. Lines are open from 08:00 to 22:00, 7 days a week. Calls are free from landlines and most mobile numbers.
