TLES16+ is a high achieving sixth form where the ambitions and aspirations of our students are supported through a culture of lifelong learning and academic excellence. Our students receive exceptional pastoral care to support their well-being and personal growth in readiness for their future.









ACADEMIC OUTCOMES

Sixth formers from the Long Eaton School recognise the importance of their education and consistently perform very well in their studies. Achieving outcomes in line with and exceeding national expectations, in both academic and vocational disciplines, our students work towards clear academic targets, and are ambitious in their pursuit of academic excellence.

THE CURRICULUM

The Long Eaton School Sixth Form prides itself on providing a wide range of courses which cater for the needs of all learners, offering academic and vocational qualifications at Level 3. The courses on offer provide the appropriate academic rigour to both challenge the student and to also prepare them for the demands of future study and employment. Within subjects, students have the opportunity to embrace a variety of curricular and extracurricular learning experiences to bolster their studies.

THE ENVIRONMENT

The Sixth Form Centre was opened in September 2014. The extensive study space includes bookable rooms for individual or group work, and a large open plan common room exclusively for sixth formers. Sixth formers have their own entrance to the school and a popular café, wi-fi is provided throughout and all facilities are available before, after and during the normal school day. Sixth formers benefit from a wide range of specialist rooms and equipment throughout the main school including science labs, ICT suites and art and performance studios as well excellent indoor and outdoor sporting facilities. Within the Sixth Form Centre, students enjoy a dedicated administrative service as well as access to a reference library, resources, information and guidance about student wellbeing and careers.



THE COMMUNITY AND PASTORAL CARE

The Head of Sixth form and our team of tutors are committed to a holistic approach to supporting the individual which emphasises academic success, social development, and personal growth with a commitment to community. Our community is inclusive, welcoming and respectful, where all young people feel safe and happy. Through a detailed program of pastoral activities, our students develop the knowledge and understanding, the skills, strategies and attributes they need for independent living and the next stage in their education or simply life after school. The program supports and meets the PSHE association core themes of Health and Wellbeing, Relationships and Living in the wider world.

Students play an active role in the development of the Sixth form through the Student Council. This representative body provides a voice for students and is responsible for a wide variety of extra-curricular, social and fundraising activities that enhance the Sixth Form experience. An established program of recognition of student leadership gives young people opportunities to develop their wider personal skills whilst providing a positive role model for younger students. Our sixth formers are leaders within the school community.

THE LEARNER

Our aim is the development of young people who will be "lifelong learners". Throughout their time in the Sixth Form, our students develop into global citizens who possess the confidence and independence required to pursue their own personal ambition, whilst recognising the needs of others and the environments and communities in which they live. Leaving the school, our students join the TLES 16+ Alumni Network.

CAREERS AND DESTINATIONS

Sixth Formers follow a detailed program of career support that addresses the individual ambitions of the students. Students have the opportunity to undertake relevant work experience, complete practice interviews, interact with local as well as regional employers and are supported thoroughly in their applications to university, higher apprenticeships or employment. Using the Unifrog platform and other providers, sixth formers have access to a host of resources including MOOCS and employment support, whilst carefully receiving the personal guidance and support from their tutor. Each year, over 70% of our students leave TLES to study at universities including Oxbridge and those in the Russell Group. Students also leave us to join Higher Apprenticeship and Degree Apprenticeship programs with local, regional and internationally recognised employers.
